

WIRELESS INTERNET ACCESS ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

The Town and Country Public Library District offers free Internet access via an open, unsecured wireless network. It is strongly recommended that you do not use such a network to transmit personal, financial or legal data. It is not possible for the Library to protect you against malicious theft or interception of such data transmitted over our network.

Library staff will provide limited functional assistance with wireless access (such as how to connect), but cannot troubleshoot a privately-owned wireless device.

Any restriction or monitoring of a minor's access to the library's wireless network is the sole responsibility of the minor's parent or guardian. A minor is considered to be 16 years of age and under.

Wireless Internet access in the library is governed by the Library's Internet Use Policy. All users are expected to use the library's wireless access in a legal and responsible manner. Users shall not violate federal, state, or local laws, including the transmission or receiving of child pornography or harmful material, fraud, or downloading copyrighted material.

This wireless network is meant as an extension of, not a replacement for the wired network. The entire library building is wireless accessible, however signal strength may vary and is not guaranteed. Printers are not available via the wireless connection at this time.

The Library staff members reserve the right to monitor use of the wireless Internet access and will terminate the user's session if use or user's behavior is deemed inappropriate according to Library policy.
